It is normal for us to have hot days that time of year, but they typically subside after 48-72 hours. Our vineyards jumped a matter of 6 brix in a week's time; normally that climb would develop over the course of 3 weeks. The 2019 Willie Mae Pinot Noir, which scored 95 points from Wine Enthusiast Magazine, is delicious with its bold spiced red plum and striking oak tannins that make it the perfect pairing for your Thanksgiving turkey. Lastly the 2019 La Cuesta Cabernet Sauvignon impresses with rich notes of cassis, espresso, dark plum and juicy blackberry. Pair this wine with your favorite holiday smoked pork loin and herbs.

### LINCOURT 2020 COURTNEY'S CHARDONNAY, Sta. Rita Hills

Named for proprietor Bill Foley's daughter Courtney, this wine boasts delicious aromas of crisp lemon zest and brioche. On the palate it is racy with minerality and nuances of flint accompanied by softer flavors of marshmallow confection, vanilla wafer, and faint notes of crushed hazelnut on the finish. This is the perfect brunch wine and will pair perfectly with an asparagus, feta, and ham frittata.

The sophisticated palate possesses striking oak tannins with notes of cranberry, crisp red apple, and black pepper — a perfect pairing with your holiday meals.

## LINCOURT 2019 LA CUESTA CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Santa Ynez Valley

The grapes for this wine come from our vineyard in Santa Ynez Valley. The combination of full sun exposure, low rainfall, long growing season, and porous soils makes this valley ideal for Bordeaux varieties. This wine has rich aromas of cassis,
